PROTEST

20 Protestant, [enter Protestant's name], files this protest under the provisions of California Vehicle
21 Code section 3062(a)(2) and alleges as follows:

22 1. Protestant is a new motor vehicle dealer selling [enter line-make] and is located at [address
23 of dealership]. Protestant's telephone number is [enter telephone number].

24 2. Respondent distributes/manufactures [enter line-make] products and is the franchisor of
25 Protestant.

26 3. Protestant is represented in this matter by [Name of Attorney or Protestant's Dealer

1 4. On or about [enter date], Protestant received from Respondent a notice that Respondent

5 5. Protestant is located within a two-mile radius of the proposed establishment/relocation of
6 the satellite warranty facility.

7 6. There is good cause under the existing circumstances for not permitting the
8 establishment/relocation of the satellite warranty facility, the reasons for which include the following:

9 (a) Protestant has made a substantial and permanent investment in the dealership.

10 (b) There will be an adverse effect upon the retail motor vehicle business and the consuming
11 public.

12 (c) It would be injurious to the public welfare for the satellite warranty facility to be
13 established/relocated.

14 (d) The [enter line-make] franchisees are providing adequate competition and convenient
15 consumer care for [enter line-make] vehicles including adequate motor vehicle service facilities,
16 equipment, supply of vehicle parts, and qualified service personnel.

17 (e) The establishment/relocation of the satellite warranty facility would not be in the public
18 interest.

19 (f) Other circumstances that would support the claim that there is good cause not to allow the
20 proposed establishment/relocation.

21 7. Protestant and its attorney(s) desire to appear before the Board and estimate that the
22 hearing in this matter will take [enter number of days] days to complete.

23 8. A Pre-Hearing Conference is requested.

24 WHEREFORE, Protestant prays as follows:

28 ¹ If, within this period of time, a franchisee files with the Board a request for additional time to file a protest, the Board or its Executive Director, upon a showing of good cause, may grant an additional 10 days to file the protest.

1 1. That the Board (or its authorized representative) immediately advise Respondent that a
2 protest has been filed;

3 2. That a hearing of the Protest is required pursuant to Vehicle Code section 3066; and,

4 3. That, pursuant to Vehicle Code sections 3062 and 3063, Respondent may not
5 establish/relocate the proposed satellite warranty facility if the Board determines that there is good cause
6 for not permitting the satellite warranty facility.
