Subject : Notification of Retirement – Honorable Anthony M. Skrocki

On behalf of the California New Motor Vehicle Board, I am writing to announce that our longest-serving Administrative Law Judge, Anthony M. Skrocki, will be concluding his distinguished tenure at the end of this year. Judge Skrocki has been a cornerstone of this Board since its inception, having been appointed when the Board first began utilizing its own Administrative Law Judges.

Prior to coming to the Board, Judge Skrocki's experience included four years in the U.S. Air Force - two years in the Office of Procurement and Contracting in Montana and two years with the Office of the Air Force Judge Advocate General in Japan. He also served over four years as a California Deputy Attorney General.

Judge Skrocki earned two law degrees - a J.D. from the University of the Pacific, McGeorge School of Law, and an LL.M. from the University of California, Berkeley Law. Upon retirement from academia, he was awarded the title of Professor Emeritus.

For over five decades, Judge Skrocki has served the people of California and the motor vehicle industry with unparalleled dedication. His contributions to the Board's mission include:

- **Expert Adjudication:** Presiding over countless merits hearings, law and motion hearings, and settlement conferences with exceptional skill and legal knowledge.
- **Professional Integrity:** Advancing and protecting the integrity of the automotive industry, helping to enhance the public's respect for the Board.
- **Legal Scholarship:** Serving as a law professor at McGeorge School of Law and co-authoring the widely utilized text, *Contracts in a Nutshell*.
- **Industry Resource:** Providing thoughtful advice and remaining accessible to

staff, parties, and counsel alike.

The Board recently issued a formal resolution expressing its profound appreciation for Judge Skrocki's five decades of service and his devotion to the public welfare of the State of California.
